


Life-time friend of Radioactive Man and Control Tower partner Dexorcist aka Simon Brown is first up to deliver his take on 'Sonic Portal' on the A side. His style has always been uncompromising and as a music lover and DJ he's been a major influence on Tenniswood's style and taste for a long time. Dexorcist turns in a Detroit influenced banger which goes deep. Ben Pest then follows with his own take of the same track. A member of funk band Pest, purveyor of Wonky Techno, music tech teacher and hardware enthusiast Ben has also released on Jerome Hill's Don't Label, I Love Acid and Horror Boogie to name a few. His take on 'Sonic Portal' is as genre bending and weighted as you'd expect. Over on the B side Pain Struck Stanley Dumb remix 'Blast Furnace' - a fast and furious electro track which was released as a digital bonus to the album. They work it into a breakneck speed techno number. Taste the amphetamine! Completing the package Biggabush (aka Glyn Bush) brings his dub influence to the mix. Bush of Rockers Hi-Fi connected with Radioactive Man during a mastering session asking to do the mix after hearing the record. The results are impressive and provide a welcome tempo and vibe change to the EP with its deep and dubby elements</p>

<p> REPRESS </p> <p>New album by the irrepressible Dutchman... The '2080' part of the album title is taken from the Roland JV2080, a legendary digital synthesizer from the nineties that was used a lot in the making of the album. Bought second-hand in Tokyo for a couple of hundred dollars, it lends the record a very dewy eyed soul, whilst the 'Crystal' part of the title stands for the self-made 'DIY germanium crystal compressor' Legowelt used throughout the writing process. The album itself features ten new tracks of pure Legowelt music mainly recorded in De Hague in the past year, but also on the road during tours of LA, the Californian desert, Tokyo (which spawned 'Crystal Cult 2080') and Tejada Gran Canaria (where 'The Future of Myself' was written.) Where his last album 'The Paranormal Soul' was an organic trip into misty forests, this one seems more concerned with medieval spirits; it's deeper, darker and the whole thing is tied together by a more coherent sense of ancient alchemy. Given the use of a DIY germanium crystal compressor during production, it's no wonder everything feels warm, fuzzy and mystic in a way that draws your attention in like that fabled philosopher's stone... glare too long and you might just turn to stone. Right from the opening track the mood is so encapsulating you are drawn right into Danny Wolfers' mysterious electronic world. From there various different tempos are explored and plenty of famed synthesiser work comes to the fore, wrapping grooves in trippy themes, impish spirits and plenty of organic lushness</p>

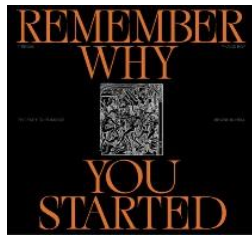

Throughout their career the duo of Dominic Paterson and Todd Nickolas released a handful of EPs on their own 'Floorshaker Productions' and two albums, one of which on Cargo Records during the time they were signed to the label. ADSR cultivated a rich and unique sound, one that ranged from piano induced euphoria to heads down serious breakbeat territory. ELEGAL3 is based around one track that originally was only available on the 1993 CD album 'Accelerated Emotions', 'Haunted' is a floorfiller comprising of piano stabs, choir vocals, depth charge basslines and acid energy. The record features the original track remastered for 2021 and two remixes, one from label boss Luca Lozano and a reinterpretation by original member Todd Nickolas. Also included is a never heard before DAT tape find of 'Menace', a grooving beast with a low slung bassline and a simple chord stab melody.</p>

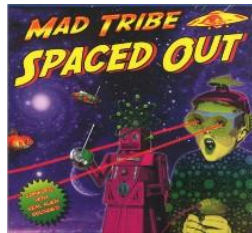
"Remember Why You Started is meant to be a message for everyone, including myself, to look back to your roots -where anything you do is influenced by nothing but passion" -Regal. Regal's genre-bending sound has been capturing the hearts and minds of ravers and industry heads since 2012. His staunch productions have garnered support from techno's well-established vanguard, including noted collaborations, projects and remixes with Amelie Lens, Hadone, Nina Kraviz, Ellen Allien, Emmanuel Top and Len Faki. Regal's sound graces clubland with full-throttle impact -whether at the legendary Berghain, Awakenings, Possession or his residency at Khidi in Tiblisi. Alongside his own productions, Regal's imprint Involve has become established for delivering sharpened 303 infused acid sounds. The imprint has welcomed artists including Boston 168, FJAAK and Alignment and is now also the home for his debut album this June. "The concept has changed a few times over the past few years" says Regal. The focus was to make an album that tells the story of his personal struggles and self-discovery, a dark insight into the DJ's life, influenced mainly by Dante Alighieri's 'Divine Comedy', where Dante has to cross all the layers of hell and purgatory to arrive in paradise. It opens with 'Respect' and its razor-sharp synth lines clamber over distorted vocal shots and glistening melodic elements. An apt introduction to Regal's earth-shattering sound, 'Burning Old Idols' plunges listeners into a four-to-the-floor techno domain, surrounded by industrial rhythm and a searing 303 acid-line for extensive club use. 'She Dances Alone' is a love trip. It bumps up the BPM for a glorious 90's techno spirited track with refreshing melodic accompaniment -the drum production is reminiscent of the militant Detroit sound we all know and love. 'Dungeon Master' emits a seemingly demonic presence as warping synths intertwine with staggered kick drums and lasering sound effects. Title track 'Remember Why You Started' flows effortlessly between gristly acid basslines and weightless ambient pads, the spaciousness of the composition is something to be revered. 'Requiem for a Friend', featuring piano virtuoso Fabrizio Rat, conveys leftfield arpeggiators suspended in a melancholic chord progression

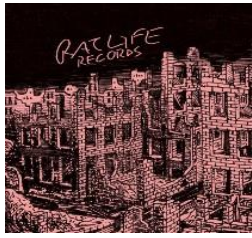

Following 2019's 'Lost In Change' and 2018's 'No Regrets' EP's, 'Pleasure Seeker' already marks her second release of the year. It's abundantly clear that few artists can compare to her consistency and quality when it comes to BEC's productions. Pulsating title track 'Pleasure Seeker' kicks off the EP. This high-impact percussive workout that seizes listeners attention with galloping kicks and snare rolls. A commanding female vocal sample purrs the track's name over and over. Echoing electro tones twist and turn throughout, creating a complex, brooding energy. 'The Truth' lays focus on a heavier rave-esque sound, enlisting a hammering rounded kick drum to open the track. From a distance, a single angelic note swirls and holds, then slowly builds. Sonic snaps fly back and forth in a scattered flurry of sound while a vocal sample with twisted distortion growls harsh truths. Dense rave chords slice through the noise to close out</p>
